



PALM SPRINGS TENNIS CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS

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A. RESERVATIONS & COURT USAGE

All Reservations for the use of the tennis courts are to be made through the Tennis Desk and court time may be booked for one and one-half (1 ½) hours (doubles or singles) on a first-come, first-served basis without distinction between Full-Season Members and Timeshare Owners. Reservations may be booked up to seven days in advance by telephone 760-318-1716, or in person beginning at 7:00am. Reservations may also be made by texting 760-902-0716; however, text reservations will not be honored until after the 7:00am call-ins and walk-ins. Reservations may be for individual players or groups of two, three or four. You must have at least two players in order to reserve a court when making the reservation. Doubles play shall have priority over singles play.

Registered guests at an Approved Associate Historic District (AHD) member hotel guests may make reservations, but they cannot be scheduled for a time when their play precludes our full-season members and timeshares owners from playing.

All unreserved court time shall be allocated on the day of play on a first-come, first-served basis, without distinction between Full-Season Members and Timeshare Owner Members

The Tennis Desk has the prerogative to arrange and rearrange the court assignments continuously in order to optimize court usage and traffic; therefore, special court assignments will NOT be guaranteed. The Tennis Coordinator has the sole discretion to determine who plays with whom. The Tennis Desk is managed by the Head Tennis Coordinator.

B. MEMBERSHIPS

Annual Full Season (Oct. 1–Sep. 30) Memberships are available as follows:

INITIATION FEE	\$ 1,000.00 (one time only)
FAMILY	\$ 1,400.00 per year*
FAMILY+ONE** (one additional adult (18) family member)	\$ 2,100.00 per year
SINGLE	\$ 1,000.00 per year*
SOCIAL (currently NOT AVAILABLE)	\$ 750.00 per year
SUMMER (June 1 through Sep. 30)	\$ 350.00 per summer***

* Member may deduct \$50.00 if paid in full by November 1st.

** May add an additional adult family member (18 years and older) to a family membership (immediate family only: parent, child, sibling or grandparent or grandchild).

*** May be applied to initiation fee if converted to annual membership.

MEMBERSHIPS (continued)

A Member has an annual revocable license to use the Club facilities and Club services in accordance with these Club rules and regulations. Family Memberships are for 2 adult people and their children under the age of 18. "Family Member" Children under the age of 18 can play at the discretion of the Director of Tennis when accompanied by an adult member as long as their playing does not preclude an adult Full-season or Timeshare Owner member from playing. The definition of a Family Membership includes and allows either both spouses, or significant others/partners, or 2 immediate adult family members (such as a man and his adult child, a woman and either one of her parents, a man and his brother or sister, or a woman and her adult grandchild or either one of her grandparents), and all unmarried dependent children under the age of eighteen (18) who are full-time students, to use the Club facilities. Single memberships entitle the Member only to use of the Club facilities. Social memberships do not include playing privileges but do include use of the fitness center and pool. Family Plus members have full use of the Club facilities and services (the same as regular Members). Approved AHD Memberships are available at the daily rate of \$25.00 per person per day and are for 1 adult person.

The Director of Tennis shall establish a maximum number of Full-Season Memberships and shall maintain a waiting list of persons approved for membership once that number has been achieved. Any Member who has not renewed his membership prior to November 1 of any year shall be subject to having his place filled from the waiting list. The Tennis Club reserves the right not to renew memberships in its sole discretion. All decisions of the Tennis Club concerning memberships shall be final. A membership is not transferable or assignable. Other than the summer membership, there are no partial-year or monthly memberships.

C. GUEST POLICY

1. Each guest of any Member will be allowed to play four (4) times per season at the rate of \$10.00 per person, per day. After the fourth time, guests will be allowed to pay \$25.00 per person, per day for a total of ten (10) additional times per season. The guest of the Member must play with that Member. Each Member will be allowed only one (1) guest in any 24-hour period. A guest cannot play if their playing precludes a Full-season or Timeshare Owner member from playing. Family members will be treated as having two individual memberships for this purpose. However, if both family Members have guests playing, each of the two family Members will be required to be on the court with each of the two guests.
2. The Tennis Coordinator will decide whether a Member should play in place of a guest at any time. It is the intent of the Club to play Members before guests at all times. Guests must be approved by the Tennis Staff prior to play and must register upon arrival. A Guest Register shall be kept at the Tennis Desk. All fees must be paid in cash or check prior to playing.

3. Non-members called on by the Tennis Desk to fill in games with Members shall also be charged \$10.00 per person, per day, and fees may be paid by either the Members or the guest(s). However, this practice will be limited and will be at the discretion of the Head Tennis Coordinator.

Fees may be waived at the discretion of the tennis coordinators for the following reasons:

- a) We are unable to fill a match (primarily off season).
 - b) The guest is someone who has expressed interest in joining the club (one time).
4. Guests must comply with all Rules & Regulations of the Club.
 5. All Members not adhering to these rules will be subject to suspension or termination at the discretion of the Director of Tennis or the President of the Palm Springs Tennis Club Members Association.

D. DRESS CODE

All tennis players, including children, are required to wear apparel designed and sold specifically for the purpose of playing tennis. This includes:

1. Only tennis shoes made specifically for the purpose of playing tennis are allowed. Black-soled shoes (unless made for tennis) or running shoes are NOT allowed on courts at any time. Soft-soled shoes (not specifically designed for tennis) scar the courts and are prohibited.
2. Men shall wear tennis shirts that have collars or “made for tennis” T-shirts that include the logo of a Tennis Manufacturer or Tennis Organization. Tennis shorts may be plain but must be made for tennis. No sweat shorts, cut-offs, bathing suits, jogging attire, or workout clothes will be allowed.
3. Shirts must be worn at all times.
4. Ladies shall wear tennis dresses, tennis shorts or skirts with “made for tennis” tops with or without collars or any “made for tennis top” that includes the logo of a Tennis Manufacturer or Tennis Organization, and tennis shoes as stated in Number 1 above. No halters, sweat shorts, denim shorts, cut-offs, bathing suits, jogging attire, or workout clothes will be allowed.
5. Players with non-conforming attire will not be allowed to play.

The Staff will interpret and enforce the dress code, and their decision is final.

E. CONDUCT AND ETIQUETTE

Members shall act in a courteous and proper manner toward other Members, guests and staff at all times. Proper tennis etiquette and conduct is required of all players using the tennis courts. Players are expected to be punctual for their matches. Loud, boisterous, or profane language, both on and off the courts, is strictly prohibited. Mistreatment or abuse of tennis courts, facilities, or equipment is strictly prohibited. Purposefully striking nets with racquets or intentionally hitting balls into windscreen curtains to practice serves or strokes are strictly prohibited. No activities shall be sponsored, conducted, or permitted in the areas adjacent to courts 1 through 9 other than those that are incidental to the normal intended use of tennis courts and facilities. Failure to comply with these rules may result in removal from the premises and/or suspension or revocation of membership.

F. TENNIS LESSONS

Tennis lessons with Tennis Club Professionals may be booked at the Tennis Desk. Full-Season and Timeshare Owner Members shall have priority with respect to reservations for tennis lessons.

No one may conduct any lessons of any kind on tennis courts without the prior written consent of the Director of Tennis.

G. CHILDREN

Non-playing children, babies in strollers, etc. are not allowed on the tennis courts at any time.

H. TOURNAMENTS AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Director of Tennis shall determine the format and scheduling of Tournaments and Club Championships. Only Full-Season and Timeshare Owner Members may participate in Club Championships. Timeshare Owner Members shall not be excluded from eligibility for Club Championship Tournaments because they are not in residence at the Palm Springs Tennis Club Resort during part or all of the period for which, or over which, the tournament is scheduled.

I. PETS

Dogs will be allowed on the patio walkway running along courts 1, 4, and 7, and on the grass area adjoining that walkway. This will enable Timeshare Owner Members who are boarding dogs locally during their Use Period to spend time with their dogs in the areas described above. All dogs must be leashed. The behavioral code for dogs is the same as for members. Their conduct cannot unreasonably interfere with the enjoyment of the Club by any Member. Termination or suspension for excessive barking or unruly behavior of any type will be immediate. Dogs are restricted from the pool, spa, and fitness facilities. No pets or animals of any kind will be allowed on the tennis courts at any time.

J. DELINQUENCIES

Members who have been notified of any delinquency in the payment of regular Club membership dues and/or guest fees shall be subject to suspension of their Club membership privileges until all delinquencies are brought current. Members who have their memberships suspended shall not be entitled to any refund for the period of suspension and shall be eligible for membership reinstatement for the remaining portion of the respective season once all delinquencies have been remedied.

K. SOLICITATIONS

No guests or Members may make any solicitations whatsoever on the premises of the Tennis Club. Any breach of this provision shall be grounds for suspension or revocation of membership.

L. SUSPENSION/REVOCAION OF MEMBERSHIP

The rights and interests of the Club supersede the rights of an individual Member. The Club has the right to make its own rules that then must be observed by all Members. Should a conflict arise between the rights of a Member and the rights and best interests of the Club, the rights and best interests of the Club must prevail.

A membership may be terminated upon the Director of Tennis' or the President of the Members Association's determination that a Member is incompatible with or disagreeable with the other Members; or has engaged in a conduct, which in his/her opinion, is reasonably calculated to endanger the welfare, interest, or character of the Club; or for any conduct in material violation of the Club rules and regulations.

The Tennis Club reserves the right to revoke or suspend the membership of any Member in the event of the violation of any of the rules of conduct and etiquette or non-solicitation provisions set forth above, or for any conduct which is detrimental to the Tennis Club and its Members. The determination of the Director of Tennis or the President of the Members Association regarding suspension or revocation shall be final and not subject to appeal. In the event of a suspension, there shall be no refund of dues during the period of suspension. In the event of revocation of membership, there shall be a pro-rata refund of the annual membership dues. Members who are suspended may elect to withdraw their membership and obtain a pro-rata refund of their membership dues.

Any Full-Season Member whose membership is revoked or suspended (except for nonpayment of dues) shall not have the right during the revocation or suspension to be at the Club or use the Club's facilities, whether as a Full-Season Member, Timeshare Owner Member, guest of a Member, or Timeshare Owner, or otherwise. The only exception to this rule is that a Timeshare Owner Member whose membership as a Full-Season Member has been revoked or suspended may nevertheless thereafter be at the Club and use the Club's tennis courts and facilities while in residence as a Timeshare Owner during Owner entitlement use time (and no other time) if he or she first obtains the approval for such use from the Timeshare Owners' Association Board and fully complies with these Rules and

Regulations and any requirements set forth by such Board in connection with granting such approval.

The Director of Tennis or the President of the Palm Springs Tennis Club Members Association, in his sole discretion but after consultation with professional staff, reserves the right to recall and thereby terminate, upon written notice, any membership or all memberships within one or more membership classifications at any time, with or without cause, without giving any reason.

M. ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Tennis Facility, viewing areas, and the patio area at Spencer's Restaurant are smoke-free environments. All tennis courts and surrounding area (inclusive of Courts 10 and 11) are also considered smoke-free areas.
2. The Director of Tennis or the President of PSTCMA may make and post additional rules and regulations governing reservations for or the allocation of playing time, prescribing standards of dress or conduct for players using the courts, or limiting the use of courts by children or guests. All persons using the recreational facilities of the Tennis Club must comply with these additional rules and regulations.

N. VOLUNTEERS AND SELF-DIRECTED WORK TEAMS

The rules and regulations of the Club are designed to protect the special character of the Club as a friendly, serene, and safe environment. The management of the Club encourages the spirit of volunteerism and belonging that has led to the donation by Members of thousands of hours and dollars to help preserve the character and experiential environment of the Club. Self-directed work teams, comprised of volunteers and professional staff, are key factors in the success of the Club. It is the Club's policy that Committees of any kind are not permitted.
